## The Rev. Izzett - H. G. (Geoff) Walburn Collection of Canadian Precancels

If you have followed our auctions over the past few years you likely know that we have been on a bit of a roll as far as precancels are concerned. We have been fortunate to sell the collections formed by John Newman, Neal Allen and Norman Wagner, among others.

When we learned that the Izzett-Walburn collection was to be sold we took an aggressive position. Rev. Izzett acquired most of the important items in the Walburn collection and together with his own holdings the result was the finest collection yet to be formed. We were eventually successful in acquiring it and have begun the long process of breaking it down into 'collector sized' lots. Besides those offered here there will be further selections in four upcoming mail auctions beginning in November of this year.

The popularity of precancel collecting was a bit slow getting started. In its infancy it was still not uncommon for collectors and dealers to consign these stamps to the garbage bin as undesirable. However, in 1918 the Bushnell catalogue appeared. Today a comparatively large body of literature is available to students interested in this fascinating field, although new finds are certainly possible. The bar types in particular offer opportunity to find new varieties.

The collection has many highlights such as the great Amherst rarities and the wonderful array of other scarce towns such as Sydney and Truro. Others are less obvious however. Rare multiples, combination types and elusive varieties abound in the collection.

I hope that you enjoy the catalogue and are able to add some needed items to your collections.
