## THE HARVEY POOLE COLLECTION

It seems hard to believe that more than six years have passed since the Harvey Poole Newfoundland collection was sold in 2008. It was a much talked about event and I am sure that the Canadian portion will be equally well received. Like the Newfoundland previously sold, the collection is very strong in essays, proofs and imperforates. Knowledgeable collectors will appreciate the myriad items that are seldom if ever available on the marketplace.

There are many highlights in the essays section including a 2c Small Queen die essay as well as a 'running horse' block of six. Also of note are the Half Cent Quebec 'Civilian Dress' die essay and the MacDonald Cartier die essays, which include the rare 50 c value. Are you interested in presentation booklets? The auction kicks off with an extensive selection, including several that we have never offered in the past.

Collectors will find a fabulous selection of stamps, die proofs and imperforates. Some of the numerous outstanding items are a mint twelve penny black, a stunning mint pair of the 10 p Cartier, imperforate corner blocks of the Widow Weeds, King Edward VII vending machine coils, imperforate pairs surprisingly more or less complete, two pairs of the part perforated \$1.00 Chateau Ramezay and rare mint QEII errors. The die proofs are also quite remarkable beginning with three (one a compound) of the twelve penny, an 1859 lc in greenish blue and 2 c in brown, a 1c Small Queen in black with lathework, Quebecs, Admirals and much more. A more modern rarity is an under-appreciated complete set of 1946 Peace Issue large die proofs in the issued colours. Some excellent large lots plus a few of the provinces close the auction.

During examination of the collection we discovered two hitherto unknown items - imperforate pairs of the 1859 10c Consort and the 1935 13c Yacht Britannia showing the 'string of pearls' variety and the 'shilling mark' varieties respectively. These will surely be listed in future editions of the Unitrade catalogue.

I hope that you enjoy the catalogue - many hours of preparation and research have gone into it.
