## THE BARON COLLECTIONS

One of the great things about our hobby is the development of a passion for a particular issue or collecting area. Melvin Baron actually had several such passions when it came to Canadian philately including first day covers and modern errors, as well as imperforate pairs, plate blocks and tête-bêche multiples.

It is always a pleasure to work with outstanding material. The Baron family acquired many such items, patiently acquiring rarities over many years. Let's start with the tête-bêche imperforates. This sale contains not only the Queen Victoria Numeral and King Edward VII strips, but the rare Admiral Issue set as well. The last time a collector had the opportunity to purchase all three of these great rarities in a single sale was in 1965, at the van Straten sale held by Robson Lowe. The 1928 Scroll Issue is also present in a dazzling array of combinations.

In addition, a number of imperforate plate blocks will also be sold. These extremely rare items are increasingly popular. The collection focused on special deliveries.

Likewise the imperforates section is the most extensive that we have ever offered. They are virtually all present in superior condition beginning with the first issues of the Dominion of Canada to the 1940s. Furthermore, we are very pleased to offer such one-of-a-kind items as the 1c orange and 2 c green Arch Issues and the 3 c Medallion die II. These have not been on the market in decades.

The current market for Canadian major errors presents a real opportunity for collectors. Seldom seen items can be had at attractive prices. While early Elizabethan errors (Karsh to Centennial period) are still well received we believe later errors from the 1970s onwards are neglected, but nevertheless just as rewarding. This particular collection features many elusive errors, including several that we have never offered before. The allure of major errors, with their striking appearance and extremely low quantities available, can only mean increasing prices in the years ahead as new collectors both at home and abroad create more demand.

Melvin Baron had a special affection for first day covers, and the family collection formed the basis of many articles about them written with his friend Stan Lum. This seminal series studied FDC's from the 1930s to 1950s and was written over a five year period starting in 1977. It helped popularize the collecting of FDC's; collectors began to realize that a lifetime could be spent on this fascinating area, searching out the different cachets, city cancelations (official and unofficial) and different combinations of stamps. The Baron FDC collection is the largest we have ever handled, filling well over twenty shipping cartons. We have divided the auction lots into two sections -- the first is the main collection and the second is larger lots. Collectors of Newfoundland will also be happy to find covers of interest. The collecting of FDC's offers many challenges, an underrated area with a bright future.

So enjoy the catalogue. I hope you will find one or more items for your collection. Viewing this collection is obviously a pleasure. With that in mind we invite you to attend the sale in person.

Queen Victoria Numeral booklet panes were printed in sheets of 168 stamps laid out in two columns, each of which contained fourteen panes arranged in seven tête-bêche strips of twelve. A plate imprint appeared above each column. At least two of the fourteen panes were broken up. We feel that one of these may have been the second plate imprint example; after exhaustive research we were unable to locate it.

Expertization: all three panes with individual 1985 Greene Foundation certificates with old Canada Specialized numbers.

The One cent and Three cent panes are without gum as issued. Both are large margined and in an excellent state of preservation. The Two cent has a minor gum thin on one stamp and in the margin, otherwise it has full original gum hinged once at centre. During our research on other 2 cent panes we found others with noticeable faults such as gum problems and creases.

A total of seven sets exist. Thanks to Leopold Beaudet's latest census (published in Admiral's Log, Vol. XIII, No. 1, Dec. 2013) we are able to give a concise summary. "SET (number)" in bold designate that we have seen the actual item or a clear illustration.

It is interesting to note that several prominent Admiral collectors such as Harry Lussey, George Marler and Abe Charkow among others, were never able to secure a set for their collections.
